

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS PRIOR TO PERIODONTAL/IMPLANT SURGERY

In order to make your periodontal/implant procedure more comfortable and pleasant, please review the following information and suggestions.

Before your appointment

- Please arrive at least 5 minutes before your appointment
- Continue to take your regular medications at the regularly prescribed time. If there is any change in your medication, please advise your dentist
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing. Avoid makeup including lipstick, nail polish etc.
- Avoid alcohol the day before and the day of the procedure
- Avoid smoking cigarette/cannabis/cigars etc. for 1 week before surgery
- If you have an illness (cold, flu, cough) on the day before your procedure, please call our office at (902) 446-2326
- Please arrange to have someone drive you home at the end of your appointment and assist you to your door
- Depending on the type of procedure, we may provide antibiotic or pain medications before we begin

Following your appointment

- Follow the post-operative instructions provided
- Do not drink alcoholic beverages for 24 hours. If antibiotics is prescribed, it is advisable to abstain from alcohol for at least 1-2 weeks
- Avoid smoking cigarettes/cannabis/cigars etc. for 3 weeks after surgery. This is obtain successful and optimal healing
